This Indenture made this 5th day of September 1813 between
Henry Waggoner, & Sarah his wife, of the County of Pulaski and State of Kentucky
of the one part, and Schabud Blackledge, of the County and State aforesaid
of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Henry Waggoner, for and in consideration
of the sum of one Dollar current money of the State aforesaid here-
by granted bargain and sold unto the said Schabud Blackledge, his heirs &c forever, a certain tract or parcel
of land situate lying and being in the County aforesaid, on the Waters of
Pinnans Creek containing by Survey ten Acres, be the same more or less, and
bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at a Black Oak thence South
31st East 30 poles to a white Oak thence South 46 West 39 poles to a Black
Walnut thence South 68 West 53 poles to a stake thence North 35 East 10 poles
to a red Oak and White Oak thence South 55 East 10 poles to the Beginning
To have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land with all and
singular its Appurtenances, unto the said Schabud Blackledge, his heirs
& forever against the Claim of the said Henry Waggoner & Sarah his wife, then
his heirs &c. and against the Claim or Claims of all and every person or persons
claiming by through or under them, with Warrant and Process to the said
Schabud Blackledge, his heirs &c. against the Claim or Claims of no other person or
persons, In Testimony whereof the said Henry Waggoner & Sarah his wife
have hereunto set their hands & affixed their seals this day and year above
written.

and Assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and
being in the County aforesaid, on the Waters of Pinnans Creek containing
by Survey one hundred forty four and one half Acres be the same

more or less. It being part of 158 1/2 Acres & thirty poles of land granted
to the said Henry Waggoner by patent bearing date the 12th day of January
1780 and bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning on three white Oaks
