This Indenture made this fifteenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred & sixteen. Between Robert Scott & Grace his wife, of the County of Pulaski and State of Kentucky, of the one part, and John Langdon of the County & State aforesaid, of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Robert Scott & Grace his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Seventy pounds ten shillings to them in hand paid by the said John Langdon the receipt whereof they the said Robert Scott & his wife doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained & sold, they these presents do hereby grant bargain sell & convey unto the said John Langdon his heirs &c forever, one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Pulaski & the waters of Chimans Creek containing by Survey seventy acres be the same or less bounded as follows to wit, Beginning at a Black gum a conditional corner made between said Scott and Langdon on the North West line of said Scotts Survey thence forty six poles to two White oaks thence on said line binding on the line of Langdons Survey 180 poles to two White oaks a corner thence on said line Southwardly 80 poles to a white oak gum & Hickory another Conditional Corner between said parties line to the Beginning To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with all & singular its appurtenances unto the said John Langdon his heirs &c forever, against the claim of them the said Robert Scott & Grace his wife their heirs &c forever and against the claim or claim of all and every person or persons Whatsoever unto the said John Langdon his heirs &c, they the said Robert Scott & Grace his wife their heirs &c Will Warrant & forever defende the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land with all and singular its appurtenances In Testimony whereof the said Robert Scott & Grace his wife have hereunto

This Indenture made the fifteenth day of April one thousand Eight hundred and sixteen and of the Commonwealth the twenty fourth Between Robert Scott of the County of Pulaski and State of Kentucky on the one part and Asa Dodson of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Robert Scott for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and thirty three Dollars current Money of Kentucky to him in hand paid by the said Asa Dodson the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged that he the said Robert Scott hath given granted bargained and sold and doth by these presents give grant bargain and sell convey and confirm unto the said Asa Dodson his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land with premises lying in said County on the waters of the Cane Fork of Chimans Creek containing Eighty Acres be the same more or less Beginning bounded as follows to wit, Beginning at a white oak Hickory & Gum a conditional corner made between said Scott and John Langdon thence South thirty five West ninety poles to locust and black oak thence North fifty five West sixty five poles to a black oak corner on Aaron Doffs corner thence forty four poles to a Hickory on said Doffs line thence on said line forty five poles to a poplar & Hickory thence Direct line to a Hickory corner to Doffs lands thence conveyed by said Scott to said Doffs thence North thirty five East twenty four poles to a gum corner made between said Scott and Langdon thence a Direct line
