Beginning on a stake in the middle of the salt works road thence to Beateses corner on crop street his line to Lights corner his line to a stake thence his line to the Beginning - It being the same lot that R. Graves purchased of James Light the said J.P. & J. W. Calyer to leave and to hold the aforesaid lot of ground to them and their heirs forever & the said Robert Graves and Hannah his wife do bind themselves to forever warrant and defend the aforesaid title against the claim or claims of all and every other persons Whomsoever.
