

## **TRACT 6:**

I) Lying and being in Pulaski County, KY, on the Somerset & Monticello Pike about one Mile south of the Courthouse in Somerset, KY, to-wit: Lots Eight, Nine and Ten in Block 3 of Tibbals Additions to Somerset, as shown on the map or plat of said Addition of Record in Pulaski County Court Clerk's Office in Deed Book 93 at Page 247. Being a part of the same property conveyed to Leon V. Colyer be Deed of Conveyance dated the 18th day of September, 1925, from Robert Hollars and Mae Hollars, his wife, and of Record in Deed Book 99, Page 303, Pulaski County Clerk's Office, Kentucky. The aforesaid Leon V. Colyer died intestate on September 26, 1953, thereby vesting one-half (1/2) interest to the hereinabove described real property to her husband, Sam Colyer, and one-half (1/2) interest to her four (4) children, Ruby Chestnut, Elaine C. Avera, Ray L. Colyer & Edith C. Curtis, pursuant to the Affidavit to Descent of record in Deed Book 278, Page 472, Pulaski County Court Clerk's Office, KY.

II) A certain lot of ground lying and being in Pulaski County, KY, on the Somerset and Monticello Pike and about one mile south of the Courthouse in Somerset, KY, and being Lot No. 7 in the Tibbals Addition to the City of Somerset, as shown on plat of said addition of record in the Pulaski County Clerk's Office in Deed Book 93, Page 247. Being a part of the same property conveyed to Ruby C. Chestnut, Ray L. Colyer, Elaine C. Avery and Edith C. Curtis by Deed of Conveyance dated the 12th day of February 1954 from Sam Colyer, a single man, and of Record in Deed Book 278, Page 197, Pulaski County Clerk's Office KY.
