purchased by one of Vincent James being in Pulaski County Co the leaders of Pittman Creek
for which a deed is now of record in the Pulaski County Court Clerk's office the said
McLean & Godley and William M Coff to have and to hold said tract of land to
themselves their heirs and should the said John Godley pay off and discharge
said debts this mortgage is to be null & void also to remain in full force until
said land is to be liable to the extent of any debt or liability of the above named
debts for which said party W B Godley and W R Coff may be responsible or may have

This indenture of bargain and sale made this 28th day of June 1862 Between
Lawry Richardson of the County of Pulaski and State of Kentucky of the first part
and Louisa J. Calyer of the County and State aforesaid of the second part testeth
that for the consideration of Eighty dollars to the party of the first part in hand paid
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged he does this day bargain and sell
to the said Louisa J. Calyer to herself her heirs and assigns forever a certain
tract or parcel of land situated in the County and State aforesaid on the water
of Pittman Creek and bounded as follows Beginning on a white oak & hickory and
Geo. Meeks line thence with his line N 85 W 22 poles to two black oaks
Geo. Meeks corner near a sink on the point of a ridge thence with the W
Calyers line S 5 W 84 poles to a white oak W P Calyers corner thence S
50 W 39 poles to two small dogwoods at a corner on A. Meeks line his line
S 40 E 73 poles to a rock on A. Meeks line thence a straight line to the
beginning containing Seventeen acres be the same more or less - the said
Louisa J. Calyer to have and to hold said boundary of land to herself &
her heirs and assigns forever and the said Lawry Richardson & Emily
Richardson his wife who join in this conveyance doth hereby agree that
they will forever warrant and defend the title to the same against all
