William Goggin is appointed Surveyor of the road leading from Buford Ford on Dickes River to where it intersect the road leading from Danville to Madison's Cornthouse in the corner of James Sawelle. and it is ordered that he with the Tithe collectors and set apart for that purpose do clear and keep the same in repair according to Law.

On the Petition of Michael Stone praying for the Establishment of a Ferry across the Cumberland River at the place now called Stones Cross Landing from his own Land on the North ^{Sides} of said River to the opposite shore. It is Ordered that the same be accordingly established, and that the rate of Tollage be for a Chaise Six pence for a Horse Six pence and for every other Carriage &c. in legal Proportion.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County pay John Neville Twelve pounds Out of the Deposition for the year 1797. for his allowance for Maintenance in the same year.

Ordered that the Clerk of this Court do bind Martin Cottoral, Orphan of Gilbert Cottoral aged 10 years to William Brown to learn the Trade of a Waggon Maker.
