Curtis of Somerset Ky., party of the second part, Witnesseth; That said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of three thousand dollars, to be paid as follows, to-wit: One thousand dollars to be paid October 15th 1921, and one thousand dollars to be paid October 15th 1922, and one thousand dollars to be paid October 15th 1923, as evidenced by three certain promissory notes for said sums executed by the party of the second part to and delivered to G.J. Lorton dated October 15 1920 and bearing interest at the rate of 6% per annum from date until paid, which notes are given in lieu of three notes of like amounts and date given by grantor herein to said G.J.
