county, state of Montana, parties of the first part, and Edd Warren of Ruth, Pulaski
County Kentucky, party of the second part, Witnesseth; That said parties of the
first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred (\$100.00) Dollars
cash in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby sell and
convey to the party of the second part, his heirs and assigns the following des-
cribed property, to-wit;:-

our undivided one ninth (1/9) interest in a certain tract of land
lying and being in Pulaski County, Kentucky on the waters of Pitman Creek, and
bounded as follows viz; Beginning on a lynn standing on a cliff of Pitman Creek,
thence N 19 W 78 poles to a stone on the bank of Pitman Creek; thence down the
creek with its meanders N 30 E 16 poles, N 48 E 28 poles, N 80 E 18 poles, S 60
E 14 poles, S 30 E 11 poles, S 5 W 36 poles, S 25 W 14 poles, S 13 W 10 poles,
S 45 W 43 poles to the beginning. Said tract containing about twenty seven (27)
acres.
