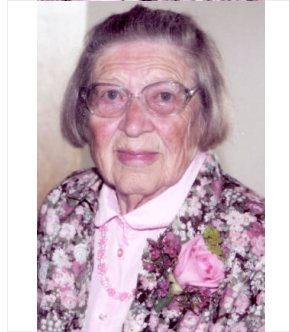




Zella Colyer
